
More Choice

Has your pet been micro chipped?

From 6th April 2016 all dogs must be microchipped by law. After this date owners of dogs in England who fail to have their dog microchipped will face a fine of up to £500. This new legislation is backed by all the main dog charities, The Kennel Club and the British Veterinary Association. At Newgate we also think it's a great idea, especially if it can help reunite a lost pet with its owner.

Our goal of being carbon neutral continues. Late in 2015 we had 80 solar panels installed on the roofs of 4 of the kennel blocks. With a 50 kW capacity the system aims to save over 10 tonnes of CO2 per year. (Whilst we are not sure about the technicalities we have been reliably informed that it's definitely good for the environment).

Cancellations

Whilst we have never charged for cancellations due to adversities or illness, we have always asked for 7 days notice to reduce or cancel.

We have had to change our policy after last year when a number of clients reduced summer bookings of 1 and 2 months down to a long weekend! For bookings 1 – 14 days (including day crèche), the 7 day rule still applies. For bookings of more than 14 days we are now asking for the same period to cancel or reduce e.g. 21 days' notice for a 21 day booking. Thank you.
